



BT Selfcare Portal Terms of Use

General Terms of Use

- 1. The use of this BT Selfcare Portal (the "Portal") is governed by the BT Compute Services contract signed by you and BT (the "Contract"). Along with the Order, the Customer Requirements Capture Form and, if applicable, a Service Level Agreement, the Contract includes the following documents (i) the BT Compute Services Terms and Conditions and (ii) the Selfcare Service Schedule, together referred to as the "Documents".
- 2. Current standard copies of the Documents, which can be found at https://www.selfcare.bt.com/asp/cgi/DirList?workspace=Default&subDir=Terms%2oand%2 oConditions
- 3. As BT may modify these standard Documents from time to time, they are provided here for reference only, and you are advised to refer to your copy of the Contract if you are in any doubt as to the terms of the Contract, including the contents of the Documents.
- 4. Should there be any differences between the copies of the Documents provided here and those forming part of the Contract, you can be certain that it is the Contract which governs your use of the Portal.
- 5. The Contract governs the use of the Portal, and any other BT services which you ordered under the Contract.
- 6. Any BT products and services which you Order through the Portal will be subject to the terms and conditions applicable to those products and services, and additional Charges.
- 7. Nothing on the Portal will vary the terms and conditions of your existing BT contracts.
- 8. The Portal may contain links to other BT or third party sites, the use of which may be covered by separate terms and conditions.
- 9. You agree to the use of Cookies as described in "Use of Cookies" below.

Use of Cookies

A "cookie" is a text file containing a small amount of information which a server downloads to your personal computer (PC) or mobile when you visit a website. The next time you visit that website or any other website, your PC checks to see if it has a cookie that the website recognises. If it has such a cookie, it communicates with the website and enables the website to read the information held in that cookie.
